



Need help to pay your water or sewer bill!



The Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) may be able to help!

CAO of Scioto County will help income-eligible households with water and sewer disconnects. The Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program provides eligible households assistance paying water and sewer bills. The program runs until September 30th, 2023.

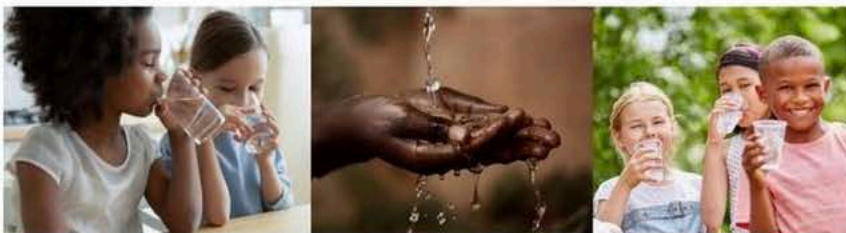
A household is eligible for assistance if they receive HEAP and/or PIPP. For two people in the household, the eligible income level is up to \$32,042. For three people, up to \$40,302.

To apply for the program, clients are required to contact the Water Assistance Program at CAO of Scioto Co., Inc.

Clients need to bring copies of the following documents to their appointment:

- Copies of their most recent water/sewer bills;
- A list of all household members and proof of income for the last 30 days or 12 months for each member;
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency for all household members;
- Proof of disability (if applicable)
