Developmental Disabilities

Developmental disabilities in preschool age children can be a challenge for parents and teachers. These disabilities can range from mild to severe and can include physical, cognitive, and/or emotional delays. For example, physical delays may include difficulty walking or gross motor skill delays in some form, while cognitive delays may include difficulty with problem-solving or language development. Early intervention is key to helping children with developmental disabilities reach their fullest potential.
